Doing Time with Dogs—and Nancy Bell, Ph.D.

Author Nancy Bell's latest project takes a look at a hardened convict, a black Lab puppy, and a disabled man locked in his own prison of pain, immobility, and isolation. When their lives converge, all are transformed.

Doing Time with Dogs tells the inspiring, true story of Huck, a convicted murderer whose life changed forever through a prison dog training program. An anomaly behind bars, the well-educated man became a published writer during his nearly 40 years in prison. He taught Joey, a bundle of black fur, intelligence, and mischief, to be a service dog. After that experience changed Huck's life, Joey became the companion of a severely disabled California man, who continues to enjoy mobility, comfort, in daily living assistance, and a new lease on a productive life. *Doing Time*

with Dogs reveals how, through these innovative prison programs all over the country, dogs are the catalyst for healing broken people.

Nancy Bell, Ph.D., has been an independent writer, editor, and communications consultant since 1980. She also is a mental health professional and a longtime animal advocate. She has coauthored two books: *Mental Health Benefits: A Purchaser's Guide* and *Pharmacy Benefits Management*. Nancy also has written extensively for national media about psychology and medicine, with particular expertise in mental health, trauma and coping, and the human/animal bond.

From 1998 to 2005, Nancy was a research assistant professor at the Florida Mental Health Institute at USF. She has taught courses in writing, communications, and human resources, including teaching English and creative writing at a federal prison, and has spoken frequently at national conferences. She presents workshops, seminars, and training on a wide variety of topics and also has extensive experience in public relations.

Nancy founded and chaired the Violence Link Task Force of Tampa Bay, a community collaborative concerned with the link between animal abuse and human violence. She conducts frequent workshops and trainings for mental health professionals on these topics.

Nancy received her doctorate in counseling psychology from Walden University in Minneapolis and a master's degree in psychology from St. Thomas University in Miami. A former member of NEW, she lives in Tampa with her husband and their dog Caleb—who is not only perfect but a certified therapy dog.
