two years became a Field Training Officer, FDLE Certified General Instructor and FDLE Certified Firearms Instructor, to actively participate in the training unit within the department. In 2004, she was re-assigned to Detective as the Crime Prevention Officer and completed her Florida Crime Prevention Practitioner course. She was tasked with the project of implementing the Airport Watch Program. The program won the distinguish Florida Police Chief's Association's Rocky Pomerance Law Enforcement Excellence Award.



This award stands in celebration of a project of excellence. The program has been the topic of several public service announcements on television and radio broadcasting systems and also the model for other aviation law enforcement agencies. In 2008, she was re-assigned to Investigator as a member of the Professional

Standards Unit, continuing the Airport Watch Program, assuming pre-employment background investigations and Internal Affairs Investigations. She was the Police Department's representative for several on site committees, coordinating events and implementing various programs.

In March of 2011, Officer Maggiasco decided that she was up for a new challenge. She interviewed and attained the position of Explosive Detection Canine Handler. Successfully completing, top of her class, the Transportation Security Administration National Explosives Detection Canine Handler Course, a 10 week course conducted at Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas. Officer Maggiasco is the first female Explosive Detection Canine Handler since inception of the K-9 Unit in 1992.
